GRADE 7 SUPPLY LIST for 2023-2024

Dear Middle School Parents,

We suggest that you take advantage of the July & August school supply sales and tax-free shopping days to stock up on school supplies for your students. At some point in the year, students run out of pens, pencils, erasers, loose-leaf paper or glue sticks which will need to be re-stocked. It is a good idea to have these items on hand at home.

We recommend a sturdy binder that stands up to the rigors of student use so it won't need to be replaced. Binders are routinely shoved, tossed and dropped, as well as opened and closed repeatedly.

Each teacher will provide separate instructions for setting up binders and supplies in their subjects.

Students should arrive on the first day of school with ALL required notebooks and supplies listed below, already labeled with name, grade and subject, as described on the attached supply list.

Please note that the following two items will be purchased by the school with your Student Activity Fees and will be distributed in the classroom:

- 1 assignment book/homework agenda
- 1 plastic 8-pocket folder

All of the following items are required for rising 7th grade students.

- 12 pens – BLUE or BLACK
- 6 pens – RED
- 24 pencils - #2, sharpened with erasers
- 1 eraser – large, pink
- 1 ruler – 12 inch/centimeter
- 2 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 box of colored pencils
- Highlighters – 4 different colors
- 1 pencil case – large, fabric, zippered (NO boxes)
- 1 pair of wired earbuds or headphones

- 4 packs of filler paper – wide ruled, 120+ sheets each → Spanish, Social Studies, personal use & collect 1

- 4 large boxes of facial tissues → to be collected
- 2 large *Lysol/Clorox* wipes → to be collected
- 2 8 oz bottles of hand sanitizer → to be collected

- For 7th graders placed in Math 7 Course 2 → 1 spiral 3-subject notebook, 1 pack of graph paper (size 4 x 4), 4 pack low-odor dry erase markers (different colors), & a cloth or dry-erase eraser.

 For 7th graders placed in Pre-Algebra 7 →
 - Spiral notebook with three holes punched to fit in binder
 - 1" sturdy binder
 - 1 pocket folder with three holes punched to fit in binder

- For ALL Math students → 1 *Texas Instruments* model #TI30XA calculator (used in Grades 6-8)

- 1 spiral 5-subject notebook → Language Arts & Literature
- 1 spiral 1-subject notebook → Religion
- 1 Flexible Poly Binder, 1 inch size, 3-ring → Social Studies
- 2 composition notebooks – 100+ sheets, wide-ruled → Science, Writing
- 3 packs of 3x5" index cards – 100 count, white, ruled → Language Arts & Spanish (2)
- 1 vinyl, BLUE, 2-pocket folder → Music

- 1 Durable Clear View binder – heavy duty, 1½ inch size, 3-ring, with a clear front pocket to insert a cover → Spanish
- 2 packs of dividers – 5 tabs, for 3-ring binder → Spanish (1) & Social Studies (1)
- Art smock & Mixed Media 9x12 Sketchbook (similar to <https://www.cheapjoes.com/canson-artists-series-mixed-media-pad-9-x-12.html>) → Art
- 4 *Book Sox* – Extra Large size, cloth book covers → Spanish, Science, Social Studies & Math
- 1 *Book Sox* – Regular/small size → Grammar
- 1 roll of clear contact paper → kept at home (to cover all soft workbooks)
- Scissors → kept at home
- Markers – fine tipped → kept at home

OPTIONAL supplies that your child may want to purchase (at your discretion):

- *Post-it* notes &/or tabs (2 x 2 inch, 3 x 3 inch, or ½ x 2 inch)
- 1 plastic, snap closure, accordion-style storage box for Spanish index cards
- 1 small pencil sharpener with cover (to fit inside pencil bag)
